BENEFITS

- Reduces missed class time for children- Even if children have to be excluded, early diagnosis and treatment allows them an earlier return to school.
- Parents may miss less time from work.
- May decrease emergency room use

PROVIDER REQUIREMENTS

- Malpractice coverage that includes treatment of patients using telemedicine
- Compliance with State licensing and other practice regulations
- Commitment to see children in a timely manner to minimize missed class time
- Completion of telemedicine visit without interruption

- Provide a schedule of provider's availability
- Share visit data with HCHD
- Communicate visit information to primary care providers and parents
- Provide contact information and accessibility to parents, especially in the evenings, to answer their questions



IT Software and Equipment-Minimal Requirements

- Laptop workstation with preferably a i3 or i5 processor (2.0 GHz+ required)
- 3 GB of DDR3 Ram or higher
- Windows 7 or newer
- Secure and reliable Internet connection via Ethernet with a bandwidth minimum of 15 MB/s download speed



- Web-based, EMR software that is HIPAA-compliant for documentation, e-prescribe, and laboratory test ordering that meets national requirements for security
- For videoconferencing, capability to adapt to changing bandwidths without losing the connection

- High definition microphone (noise & echo cancellation is recommended) that is compatible with laptop headset
- Monitor large enough in size to allow viewing screens for provider and school nurse
- High definition, integrated, movable web camera (1.2 MP or better)



- Attachments or instruments to examine and transmit images of body parts
- Auscultation platform for remote stethoscope
- Technical support and maintenance



PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT

- Minimal background noise
- Secured, private space to ensure confidentiality (if glass on interior walls, shades or other covering for privacy)
- Adequate space for the telemedicine equipment

- Sufficient lighting and if a window is present, shades to block any emanating light
- Telephone or connectivity for cell phone
- Secured fax machine to send copy of EMR to child's primary care provider if not being sent electronically
